- TICKETS -

Tickets can only be purchased online see www.campsoulfestival.com There are no reserved places you must get a ticket.

If you wish to camp please purchase relevant Tent/Campervan or Caravan/Motorhome pitch.

We have a Family Area where you can camp if you wish, though Caravans/Motorhomes will have a designated area.

If you have a weekend pass & camping pitch and are not leaving the site all weekend then you may park a car or small van next to your tent, if you plan to leave the site over the weekend then you must park in the designated parking area.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to Fire Risk/Health & Safety, we have been advised that last year there were too many cars in the camping area. To improve safety we can only allow those purchasing a camping pitch to park their car next to their tent. If you are sharing a tent and did not purchase the camping pitch you must park in the designated parking area.

Please remember to bring plenty of water with your for the weekend. Bottled water will be available to purchase but there is no running water available on site.

There are a number of food outlets on-site serving hot & cold food and drinks. There is also a beer tent; you may also bring your own.

There are Portaloos available around the site, there is also a Disabled toilet within the VIP area, please contact a member of the Campsoul staff if you need this facility over the weekend. All are serviced regularly throughout the weekend.

Whilst we, Soulpower Promotions (SP) want you to enjoy the event, we are still aware of the need to comply with any Health and Safety matters to include any Fire Safety Procedures for all in attendance.

The Camp Soul Music Festival Health and Safety Policy (along with our Fire Risk Assessment, from the Event Management Plan - EMP) is available at the main gate, situated at the entrance to the venue should anyone wish to view it.

- 1. Please be aware of the Fire Points around the venue in particular the Fire Assembly Point, in the event of any emergency.
- 2. Should you be aware of any immediate dangers/hazards please contact a member of the SP team at any time and they will take appropriate action.
- 3. In the event of an accident/injury The British Red Cross will be on site over the weekend they will be available at the contact point, near the main gate.
- 4. In an Emergency dial 999. Non-emergency dial 101.

Admission:

Those with exclusive Friday Club passes* may arrive from 12:00 (Midday) Friday. Weekend passes may arrive from 08:00 Saturday morning.

Please do not arrive any earlier than the times stipulated above

Saturday/Sunday Day passes – The music kicks-off at midday both days, you are more than welcome to arrive before, and if you are camping you may arrive from 08:00. **Saturday night campers** you must vacate the site by 10:30 Sunday morning.

All Wristbands will be issued on arrival and must be worn for the duration of the festival Please note: the gate will close at 7pm Friday, Saturday & Sunday – Please arrive before 7pm, entrance will not be permitted after this time.

The site must be vacated by all campers by 12:00 (Midday) Monday

***Friday Club passes**— If you purchased your Weekend Pass after 7th March 2017 they <u>do not</u> include Friday Club and you will not be able to gain admission.

Access:

If you have any specific access requirements, please contact us before purchasing tickets, to ensure that we can accommodate your requirements.

Care of Children: All children must wear wristbands with their 'parent/guardian' mobile number written on it, using indelible ink. Any child who is lost, will be taken to the main gate for safety and the 'parent/guardian' will be contacted via the mobile number on the child's wristband. We will also make an announcement over the PA system, on the Main Stage, Marquee and A-Frame bar; for safety reasons, the child's name will not be announced.

Whilst we do all we can to ensure children are in a safe environment, parents/guardians are responsible for them at all times.

General Security: Please do not leave any personal belongings in open, unmanned tents/ caravans. We cannot be held accountable for criminal acts committed by members of the public and will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or theft of personal belongings anywhere on site. We strongly recommend that you do not bring items of value with you to the Festival.

Music Policy:

We must stipulate that <u>Under No Circumstances</u> should you bring any PA/SOUND SYSYEMS to the festival. Our licence states all music must end at 1am, we have families on site and it is unfair on them and other people around who want to sleep!

The main stage music stops at 11pm the music is then confined to the A frame Bar and the Marquee, there is to be NO other music from personal music players after 11pm in respect to other festival goers and to comply with our licencing. We have to adhere to a strict sound level control for our music licence for the festival. We are only licenced for 3 music venues; The Main Stage, The Marquee and The A-Frame Bar.

Our Event Management Plan demands that we are to carry out sound level controls throughout the weekend, this is due to having houses close by and also the nearby village of Harwell. These tests are carried out by our sound engineer on site, and the local council who monitor the sound from outside of the festival. With this in mind the Main Stage will finish at 11pm Saturday and Sunday, on Saturday the Marquee and A-Frame will finish at 1am, and on Sunday the Marquee will finish at midnight, the A-Frame at 1am.

Like any festival/music event there will be some flashing lights on the main stage during performances and within the Marquee and A-Frame Bar.

Valuables: The Police will be notified immediately of any theft taking place on site – whether it be financial or personal items. Please be aware of all your personal belongings, whilst on site.

Toilets: Please ensure that only toilet tissue provided is flushed down the toilets, anything else must be disposed of in the waste bins provided.

Caravans/Motorhomes waste - There will be a designated area for waste for those who are staying in Caravans/Motorhomes — please <u>do not</u> flush down the main toilets or portaloos. Those renting Caravans please refer to the user manual in your caravan.

Refuse: There are plenty of refuse bins around the site. Please ensure that you take any large items home with you. Please do not leave them on site! Thank you

Fire Pits/BBQs: Any campfires must be a standard fire pit / All BBQs are to be used sensibly and with caution. Please ensure that all BBQs and fire pits are fully extinguished after use.

Dogs: Whilst dogs are welcome, we must stipulate that they must be kept on a lead and under control at all times, and owners must remove defecation immediately. ALWAYS POOP& SCOOP!

Fireworks/Chinese Lanterns: Please do not bring these to the Festival.


Promotional Flyers: Please do not bring these to the Festival.
