STRICTLY TICKETS ONLY

Tickets can only be purchased online see www.campsoulfestival.com There are no reserved places you must get a ticket.

If you wish to camp please purchase the relevant Tent/Campervan or Caravan/Motorhome pitch.

In order to camp next to friends you will need to make sure you arrive together.

If you have a weekend pass & camping pitch and are not leaving the site all weekend then you may park a car or small van next to your tent, if you plan to leave the site over the weekend then you **MUST** park in the designated parking area.

PLEASE NOTE: ONCE PARKED YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO LEAVE THE CAMPING SITE.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to Fire Risk/Health & Safety, we can only allow those purchasing a camping pitch to park their car next to their tent. If you are sharing a tent and did not purchase the camping pitch you must park in the designated parking area. Parking in the designated parking area is £10 for the weekend (Cash Only)

> There is fresh running water available from the Club House 24 hours a day. Bottled water will be available to purchase.

Food Outlets TBC

Although we allow food and drink to be brought onto site, we ask that you support our food outlets and Bar.

Strictly no drink in the Club House area, unless purchased from the Bar.

Please do no bring Fire Pits or Coal BBQs.

There are both Male & Female toilets in the Club House, as well as showers. WITE PERIOD AT ALL THATS WRIST BANDS MUST There will also be Portaloos available around the site. All will be Serviced regularly throughout the weekend. FOR THE DURATION

Please note: Off site Car Parking and Shower Wristbands is CASH ONLY and can be purchased at the Main Gate.

Whilst we, Soulpower Promotions (SP) want you to enjoy the event, we are still aware of the need to comply with any Health and Safety matters to include any Fire Safety Procedures for all in attendance.

The Camp Soul Music Festival Health and Safety Policy (along with our Fire Risk Assessment, from the Event Management Plan - EMP) is available at the main gate, situated at the entrance to the venue should anyone wish to view it.

- 1. Please be aware of the Fire Points around the venue in particular the Fire Assembly Point, in the event of any emergency.
- 2. Should you be aware of any immediate dangers/hazards please contact a member of the SP team at any time and they will take appropriate action.
- 3. In the event of an accident/injury there will be a first aider on site over the weekend who will be available at the Main Gate.
- 4. In an Emergency dial 999. Police Non-Emergency dial 101. Urgent but not life-threatening dial 111.

Admission:

Those with exclusive Friday Club passes* may arrive from 12:00 (Midday) Friday. Weekend passes may arrive from 10:00 Saturday morning.

* If your ticket states it is a Weekend Pass it <u>DOES NOT</u> include Friday Club. Please do not come Friday as you will be turned away.

Please do not arrive any earlier than the times stipulated above

Saturday Day passes – The music kicks-off at midday both days, you are more than welcome to arrive before, and if you are camping you may arrive from 10:00am.

Saturday night only campers you must vacate the site by 10:30 Sunday morning.

There will be NO SUNDAY PASSES this year.

All Wristbands will be issued on arrival and must be worn for the duration of the festival Please note: the gate will close at 7pm Friday, 2pm Saturday – entrance will not be permitted after this time.

The site must be vacated by all campers by 12:00 (Midday) Monday

Access:

If you have any specific access requirements, please contact us before purchasing tickets to ensure that we can accommodate your requirements.

Care of Children: All children must wear wristbands with their 'parent/guardian' mobile number written on it, using indelible ink. Any child who is lost, will be taken to the main gate for safety and the 'parent/guardian' will be contacted via the mobile number on the child's wristband. We will also make an announcement over the PA system, for safety reasons, the child's name will not be announced. Whilst we do all we can to ensure children are in a safe environment, parents/guardians are responsible for them at all times.

General Security: Please do not leave any personal belongings in open, unmanned tents/caravans. We cannot be held accountable for criminal acts committed by members of the public and will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or theft of personal belongings anywhere on site. We strongly recommend that you do not bring items of value with you to the Festival.

Music Policy:

We must stipulate that <u>Under No Circumstances</u> should you bring any PA/SOUND SYSYEMS to the festival.

There is to be **NO** other music from personal music players after 11pm in respect to other festival goers and to comply with our licencing. We have to adhere to a strict sound level control for our music licence for the festival. We are only licenced for 2 music venues.

Our Event Management Plan demands that we are to carry out sound level controls throughout the weekend, this is due to having houses close by. With this in mind the Marquee will finish at 10pm Saturday and Sunday. The Jimmy Cobb Bar (Club House) will finish at 1am Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Our licence states all music must end at 1am, we have families on site and it is unfair on them and other people around who want to sleep!

Like any festival/music event there will be some flashing lights within the Marquee and The Jimmy Cobb Bar.

Valuables: The Police will be notified immediately of any theft taking place on site – whether it be financial or personal items. Please be aware of all your personal belongings, whilst on site.

Toilets: Please ensure that only toilet tissue provided is flushed down the portaloos, anything else must be disposed of in the waste bins provided.

Showers – a separate wristband can be bought from the main gate for £10 (**Cash Only**) if attendees wish to use the showers on site, this will be unlimited use for the weekend. Under 16's are free.

Please **DO NOT** use the showers if you have not purchased a shower wristband.

Caravans/Motorhomes waste - There will be a designated area for waste for those who are staying in Caravans/Motorhomes — please <u>do not</u> flush down the main toilets or portaloos. If you are renting a Caravan please refer to the user manual in your caravan.

There are no electricity hook-ups on site

Refuse: There are plenty of refuse bins around the site. Please ensure that you take any large items home with you. Please do not leave them on site! Thank you

Fire Pits/Coal BBQs: No Fire Pits or Coal BBQs – Please <u>do not</u> bring to the festival. This follows advice from the Fire Brigade and Local Council. This is for everyone's safety.

Dogs: Whilst dogs are welcome, we must stipulate that they must be kept on a lead and under control at all times, and owners must remove defecation immediately. ALWAYS POOP & SCOOP!

Fireworks/Chinese Lanterns: Please do not bring these to the Festival.


Promotional Flyers: Please do not bring these to the Festival.
